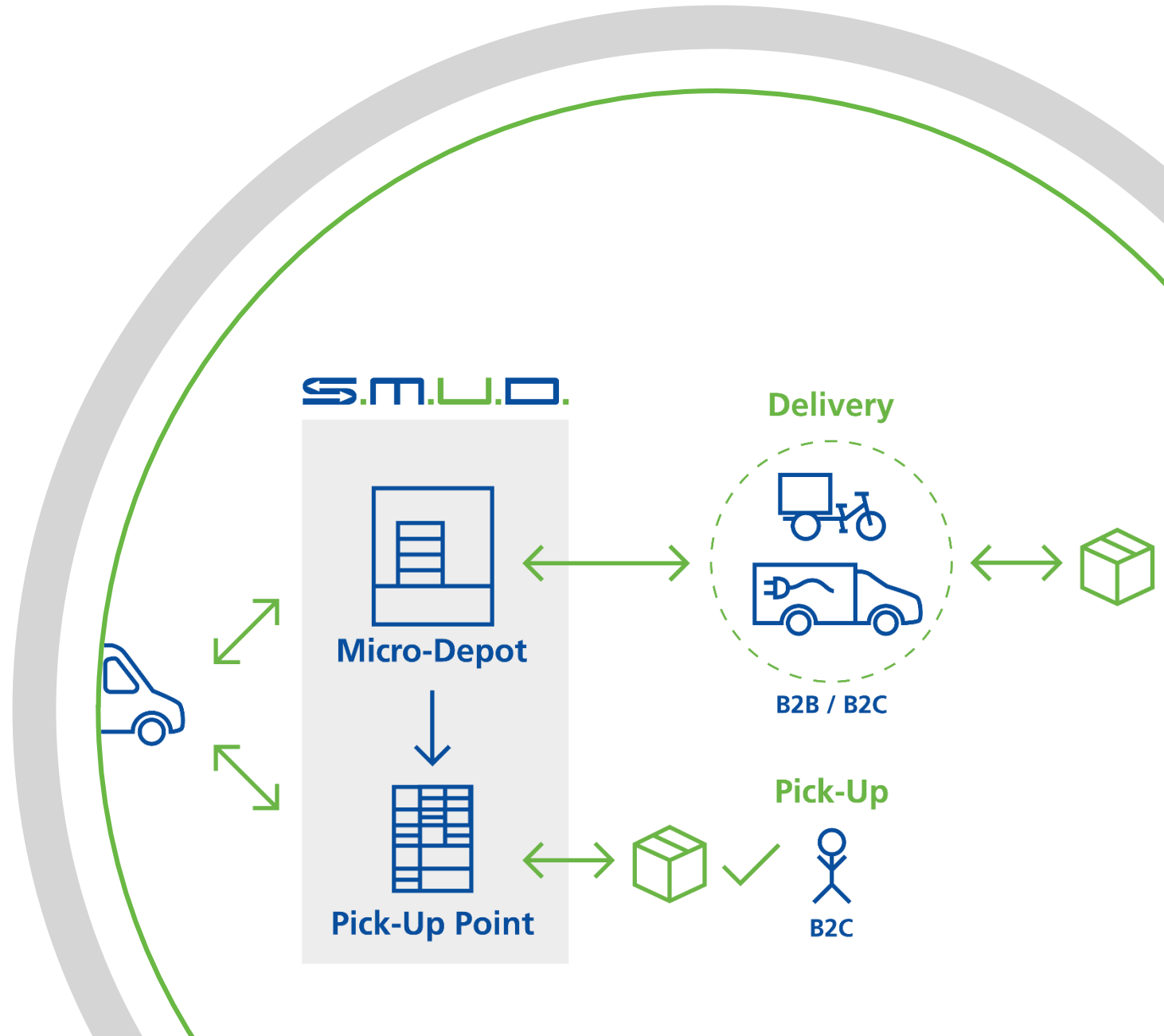

- A logistics facility in/near an urban area

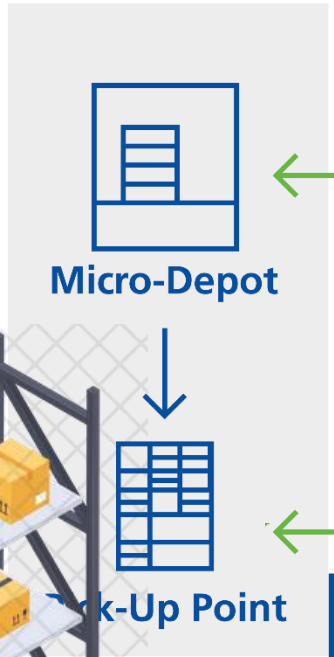

- Multiple companies at a single location.
- **CORE Business:** Logistics.
- **AUXILIARY Businesses:** Not necessarily.

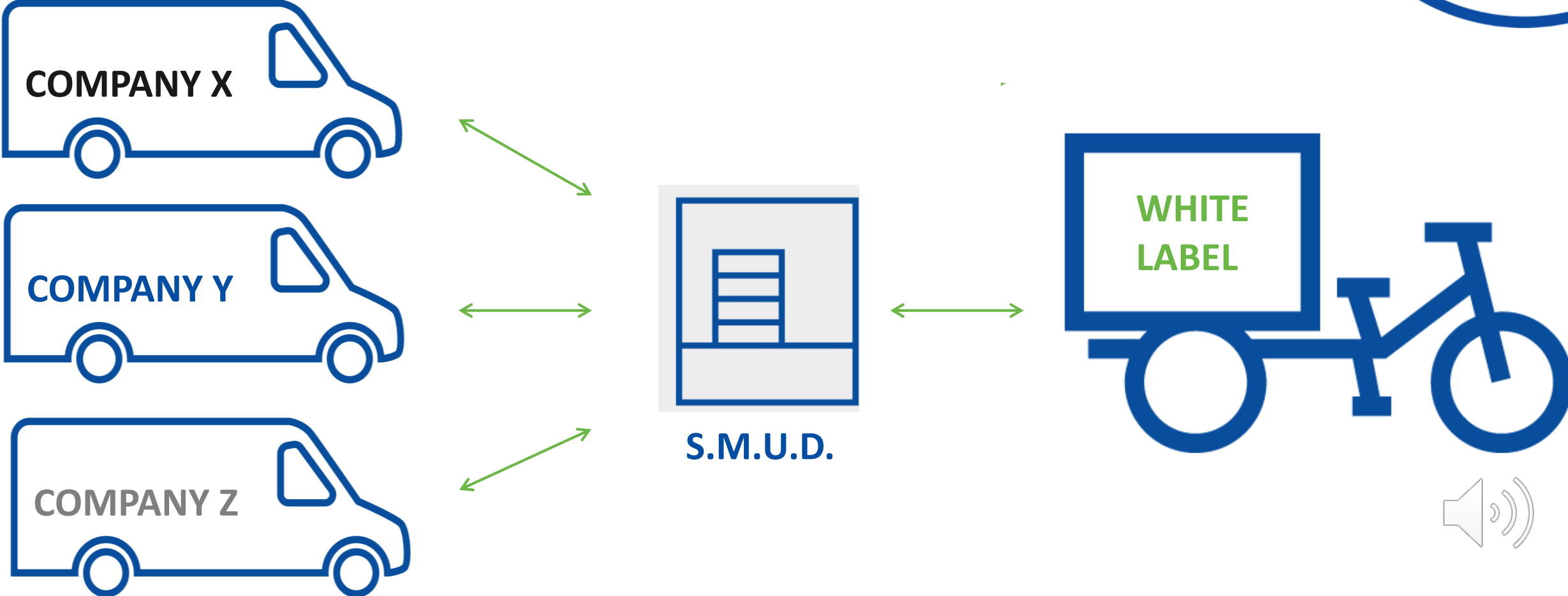


What is a **shared** micro-depot?

Sharing business also

- **CORE Business**

One company responsible for deliveries on behalf of others.



What can you **gain** from the shared micro-depots?

- **Companies:** cost reduction, improved customer service, be the innovation reference in city logistics.
- **Customers:** more and better services available at home/office or very close to home/office. One contact point.
- **Cities:** less congestion, emissions, and noise. Facilities strategically located that add value to residents. Less space taken up for logistics.
