1. City Context

Stuttgart is the biggest city and the capital of the federal state of Baden-Württemberg in Germany, with a population of around 635,911 inhabitants in the city area and ca. 2.8 million inhabitants in the metropolitan area¹ global car manufacturers such as Daimler or Porsche were founded and have their headquarters located in the city. The city area (water included) covers roughly 207.33 km².

Stuttgart has a strong history when it comes to mobility – especially in terms of cars and the automotive industry. Given its strong history in transport, it is not surprising that Stuttgart has also ambitious strategic plans for the future of mobility. Current strategic ambitions are defined amongst others in the following concepts:

- Verkehrsentwicklungskonzept 2030² (Transport Development Concept 2030)
- Nahverkehrsplan³ (Local Mobility Plan)
- Aktionsplan “Nachhaltig mobil”⁴ (Plan of Action “Sustainable Mobility”)
- Masterplan “Green City Plan”⁵
- DigitalMoveS Strategy⁶

Today, transport development planning is much more than the modal split – dividing traffic into cars, trains, buses, cyclists, and pedestrians. Transport must be considered in the context of the environment, urban design, and compatibility of urban mobility needs and sustainable lifestyles. This is the only way to ensure that the mobility needs of Stuttgart's citizens are considered.
