In order to support the vision of creating more liveable urban spaces, EIT Urban Mobility is opening a call for applications for a Business Creation Managers – to be located in Helmond - Netherlands. The Business Creation Manager will be responsible for supporting and developing business creation activities in his regions.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Business Creation Manager is part of the pan-European Business Creation team and will be based in Helmond, Netherlands. The Business Creation Manager will work in a matrix organization where he/she reports to the Business Creation Director in Barcelona whilst supporting the regional Innovation Hub activities under the direction of the regional Innovation Hub Director. The primary focus will be to monitor and develop business creation activities within the partner network and scout, coach and support start-ups in the designated geographic region.

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This includes the following tasks:

- Support the partners in their delivery of business creation activities and coach them in concretizing opportunities for new calls for proposals.
- Participate in the selection jury for EIT Urban Mobility startup and scale-up programmes.
- For EIT Urban Mobility's investment process drive the due diligence of startups and scale-ups based in the region in preparation for the investment committee and management team decision.
- Support the Hub Director in developing and strengthening the regional partner network.
- Monitor KPI's, progress and funding of the region's business creation programmes.
- Liaise with incubators, accelerators and governmental initiatives aligned with EIT Urban Mobility's Strategic Plan.
- Coordinate best practice exchange in business creation, and opportunities to drive Europe-wide take-up of solutions/products/services offered by supported startups.
