- Calls Programme sets out the area's **annual strategy of cascading activities**: all funded activities that will be delivered through Calls for proposals/Prizes (Financial Support to Third Parties)
- EIT requirement: the Call programme is a **new DEL to submit to EIT every year and to make it public**.

# Calls programme 2023 - Academy: second open call

## Type and title of the call

**Regular Second Open call for Academy** for the BP2023-25 to fund the development of new methods, content and business models to improve:

1. Master School
2. The **DTN** \*running operations.
3. Through partner-led projects, as part of our experimental approach to test new ideas, that when shown to work, may be repeated and scaled up.

*\*The DTN segment will be included in the second call for Academy for the BP2023-25 if there is a specific portfolio need*

## Type of applicants

Research institutions, universities, business schools, industry, including consultancy firms and cities.

## Type of activities

### Master School

- Development of innovative teaching methodologies, crucial for the EIT Urban Mobility offer of high-quality education and supporting the EIT labelled programmes.
- Activities meant to raise awareness of the Master School and promote our programmes, such as undergraduate summer schools and challenge-based student competitions.
- Summer Schools \*Not all the types of activities listed above may be included in the call.

### DTN

- Development of new teaching methodologies in innovation and entrepreneurship and courses with a strong business creation component and KTI approach.
- Support to student start-ups activities.

### CHA

- Applied courses with high revenue potential and addressing the EIT non-degree label requirements.
- Flagship F2f courses covering in demand hot topics in UM and skills-development needs of UM professionals. These will be targeted to the manager/director/leadership segment of the UM training market and will be specifically designed to comply with the non-degree EIT label.
- Extension and/or upgrade of successful courses and trainings, including also to cover new geographical areas and languages.
- Marketing and sales development support for new and existing courses, including also with the creation of specific events around cities and countries to generate leads to channel our courses.

# Calls Programme 2023 - Academy: call for EIT Urban Mobility partners

## Type and title of the call

---

**Call to EIT UM partners** to fund specific activities aimed at addressing a portfolio gap

## Type of activities

---

Specific activities aiming to address a portfolio gap or stretch.  
There can be a portfolio gap when:

- A certain issue has not been adequately covered by the proposals received in the open call.
- When there is a particular request for a customised training/programme targeting a specific unmet need.
- When we require extra assistance to implement and deliver our committed online and face-to-face portfolios.
- When an existing project is successful enough so that it can be improved and scaled up, also with new partners.
- When a partnership is successful enough so that it can work on new collaboration opportunities to meet the portfolio needs.

### The type of activities, amongst others, are:

- Marketing and sales development support for new and existing courses, including also with the creation of specific events around cities and countries to generate leads to channel our courses.
- Extension and/or upgrade of successful courses and trainings, including also to cover new geographical areas and languages.
- Design/production/delivery/promotion/commercialisation of online and applied courses covering in demand hot topics in UM and/or skills development needs of UM professionals.

# Calls Programme 2023 - Innovation: second open call

## Type and title of the call

---

**Second Open Call for Innovation** for the BP2023-25 to fund new entrepreneurial innovation projects. Specific requirements for RIS countries will be integrated as part of the call.

## Type of activities

---

- New entrepreneurial innovation projects addressing EIT Urban Mobility challenge areas: Mobility & Energy, Future Mobility, and Sustainable City Logistics.
- Focus on Public Transport Operators (Public Transport/Mass transit providers). PTOs will be able to represent the city.

## Type of applicants

---

All type of organisations: cities, public transport operators, start-ups, SMEs, large companies, industry, etc.

## Type and title of the call

---

**First Small Open call for Innovation** for the BP2023-25 to fund SME projects of 6-8 months with funding up to 60k EUR.

## Type of activities

---

- High impact TRL 7 & 8 solutions requiring key development linked to new technologies such as 5G, AI, etc.
- Solution should address any of the 3 EIT Urban Mobility challenge areas: Mobility & Energy.
- Sustainable City Logistics or Future Mobility.
- Single partner activity for SMEs.
- SMEs to demonstrate improved product/solution with a new client or a new product with an existing client.

# Calls Programme 2023 - Innovation: call for EIT Urban Mobility partners

## Type and title of the call

---

**Targeted Call for EIT UM partners addressing 4 specific identified topics.**

## Type of activities

---

The targeted call will address 4 topics identified as: The targeted call will address 4 topics identified as: a gap in the project portfolio, an issue not adequately covered by the proposals received in the open call, or a subject that requires urgent attention due to policy, regulation or force majeure. The targeted call aims to fund activities that will fill these gaps.

Potential topics include: Energy (hydrogen), car AI (autonomous), critical national infrastructure in cities (railway, bus networks, depots, telecom network), health, waterborne mobility, and drones.

# Calls Programme 2023 - Innovation: permanently open call

## Type and title of the call

---

### **Permanently Open call: RAPTOR Agile Innovation Call**

One call for the 3 years but with 1 cut-off date per year. The only thing that changes is the city where the competition takes place and their niche challenge.

## Type of activities

---

- RAPTOR is a competition for startups/SMEs who can address niche urban mobility challenges.
- Each competition takes place in a specific city and may address one or multiple challenges.
- 10 competitions (2 per Innovation Hub) will be launched throughout 2023. The Innovation Hubs will be in charge of selecting the host cities.

Start-ups and SMEs.

## Type and title of the call

---

**Permanently Open calls targeted to start-ups.** This call will be permanently open with 4 cut-off dates each year.

## Type of activities

---

This call aims at providing funding support to start-ups and scale-ups. EIT UM will invest in these start-ups.

## Type of applicants

---

Targeted to start-ups.

## Call key tentative dates

Launch: February 2023

Tentative 1st cut-off date: April 2023

# Calls programme 2023 - RIS education: second open call

## Type and title of the call

---

**Regular Second Open call for RIS Education** for the BP2023-25 to fund projects that address pressing skills gaps hampering innovation and entrepreneurship in urban mobility in the RIS countries, presenting solutions to local problems

## Type of activities

---

Activities that raise awareness about sustainable urban mobility through education-focused citizen engagement projects, summer schools at the bachelor level for RIS countries' students, also aiming at raising awareness of the EIT Urban Mobility Master School and off-the-shelf courses and programmes that can be used by partners in RIS countries to deliver on their education driven targets.

# Calls programme 2023 - Market Development: permanently open call

## Type and title of the call

---

### **Permanently Open call for Market development activities with cities.**

The call will be open for 1 year with up to 4 cut-off dates (4 cities, 3 challenges per city).

## Type of activities

---

- An open call is launched by EIT Urban Mobility in cooperation with the city to select innovative solution providers capable of delivering a pilot addressing specific challenges to be identified by the 4 cities: Braga, Vitoria, Heraklion, and Larissa.
- A lump sum mechanism is to be developed for this type of call to fund the pilot implementation (acquisition of hardware materials, marketing for user engagement, staff time devoted to the implementation of the pilot, data acquisition for impact assessment and expenses associated to implementation (set up and maintenance).

- Documentation to create replicable engagement guides and training activities to support broader dissemination and impact within EIT UM network.

- Support to co-develop and co-deliver EIT UM-branded projects to engage with citizens (e.g., bicycle training, serious games, parklet programmes, etc.). Scale past citizen engagement and public realm projects and create replicable engagement activities for EIT Urban Mobility.
- Demonstrate specific citizen engagement technologies or activities.
