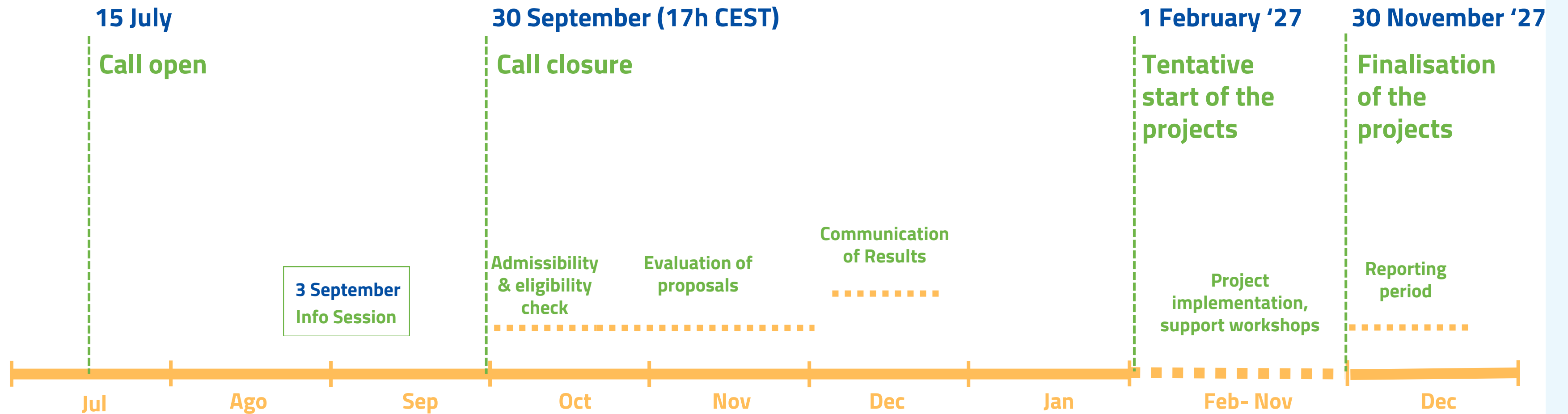

Timeline



Proposals for both programmes must serve the purpose of:

- **the 3 NEB values:**
 - Sustainable: from climate goals, to circularity, zero pollution, and biodiversity.
 - Beautiful: quality of experience and style, beyond functionality.
 - Together: from valuing diversity to equality for all, accessibility and affordability
- **the 3 key NEB guiding principles:**
 - A multilevel approach: from global to local
 - A participatory approach
 - A transdisciplinary approach

Key goal

Connect NEB

Improvement of communities' quality of life through community-led participatory processes, living labs, and/or experimental prototyping solutions based on NEB values.

Co-create NEB

Transformation of neighbourhood public spaces through collaboration between communities and public authorities.

Public space

Any space (e.g. streets, parks, town squares) that is open and accessible to everyone. This refers primarily to publicly owned spaces, but in some cases may also include privately owned ones. Such spaces are typically designed for the benefit of the community and may be used for social interaction, economic exchange, or cultural activities.

Thematic Areas

Applicants must select a primary thematic area in which the project fits, and might select a secondary thematic:

- Urban Mobility
- Food
- Climate

Who can apply?

Connect NEB

Co-create NEB

Applicants can submit only one proposal as Lead Partner across the two programmes

- **All legal entities**
- **Applicant Eligibility:** the applicant is a legal entity established in the Member States of the EU and/or in Third countries associated with Horizon Europe (countries associated with Pillar 2 are not eligible for this call).
- **Consortia are not allowed** in this programme.
- **Co-create NEB participation:** the applicant who submitted a proposal under the programme Connect NEB Open Call 2027 has not submitted a proposal under the programme Co-create NEB call 2027 as Lead Partner.

- **All legal entities**
- **Applicant Eligibility:** All consortium members must be legal entities established in the Member States of the EU and/or in Third countries associated with Horizon Europe (countries associated with Pillar 2 are not eligible for this call).
- **Consortium Composition:**
 - between 2 and 4 partners:
 - At least 2 entities must be independent of each other
 - One partner must be a **local/regional** public authority or an entity affiliated with a public authority.
 - In the case of an affiliated entity: submit legal registration/official document or a Declaration of Affiliation template.

Budget

Connect NEB

- Total fixed budget of **EUR 18,000 per proposal**
 - **EIT funding of EUR 15,300** = 85% of the budget
 - **Co-funding of EUR 2,700** = 15% of the budget
- **Costs justification:** As it is lump-sum funding model, there is no need to provide a detailed breakdown of specific amounts in the application or at the end of the project.
 - Payments is based on the successful implementation of the project and the achievement of the agreed KPIs and mandatory deliverables.

Co-create NEB

- Total fixed budget of **EUR 58,000 per proposal**
 - **EIT funding of EUR 49,300** = 85% of the budget
 - **Co-funding of EUR 8,700** = 15% of the budget
- **Costs justification:** As it is lump-sum funding model, there is no need to provide a detailed breakdown of specific amounts in the application or at the end of the project.
 - Payments is based on the successful implementation of the project and the achievement of the agreed KPIs and mandatory deliverables.
- **All partners must have a budget allocated** (participation of partners with a total budget of EUR 0 is not permitted), either from EIT funding and/or from co-funding.
- **Different partners may have different % of EIT budget and co-funding.** To help calculate these percentages, applicants can use the Excel support sheet provided

Payment Arrangements

- **50% pre-financing payment of the EIT funding** upon signature of the contract documents:
 - Financial Support Agreement (FSA) by all partners
 - Declaration of Honour (DoH) by all partners
- **50% final payment of the EIT funding** upon submission and approval of the mandatory deliverables and the KPIs.
 - At the end of the project, the assessment and final payment will be based on the completion and quality of the deliverables and KPIs, showing that the activities were successfully implemented and the expected results achieved.
 - A grant reduction may apply depending on the level of completion (Annex 2 - Financial aspects).

Admissibility

- Applications must be submitted **before the call deadline (30 September, 17h CEST)**
- Applications must be submitted using the application forms provided in the EIT Urban Mobility **Programmes portal (NetSuite)** (see Section 7.2).
- All **partners must be registered EIT Urban Mobility Programmes Portal** (NetSuite) and **must have completed the Partner Information Form (PIF)**, including their correct PIC number.
- Applications **must be complete** and contain all parts and, if any, supporting documents.
 - Supporting document required only for Co-create NEB, if applicable
 - Co-create NEB proposals that do not include a public authority in the consortium must include an affiliated entity among their partners. In such cases, a Declaration of Affiliation must be submitted. Template in the Web page.
- Applications and their supporting documents must be **written in English**, and must be readable, accessible and printable.
- Applications must **respect the characters' limits** established in the application form

Applications missing the mandatory supporting document (if applicable) or submitting blank or wrong documents will be automatically rejected during the admissibility check.

Connect NEB

Selection of 8 proposals

- Proposals **equal or above 35 points** in accordance with the ranking list.

Co-create NEB

Selection of 9 proposals

1. Proposals **equal or above 45 points** will be ranked by score **within their primary thematic area**: Climate, Urban Mobility or Food (3 per thematic area)
2. If fewer than 3 proposals are selected within a thematic area, proposals **may be considered for funding under their secondary thematic area**, following the order of ranking and provided that the secondary thematic area is relevant to the project
3. Where no suitable proposals with a relevant secondary thematic area are available, remaining positions may be filled by the next highest-ranked proposals across all thematic areas, by score.

- If as a result of the evaluation, two or more proposals receive the same scoring, funding prioritisation will be based on:
 - Geographical spread within the EIT Community NEB Portfolio
 - Newcomers to the EIT Community NEB ecosystem

How to submit a proposal

Before starting to draft a proposal, all applicants must follow the following steps:

Step 1: Obtain a Participant Identification Code (PIC)

All applicants submitting to this Call must register themselves in the [EU Funding & Tenders Opportunities Portal](#) to obtain a valid nine-digit PIC number.

Step 2: Register or access the EIT Urban Mobility Programmes Portal (NetSuite)

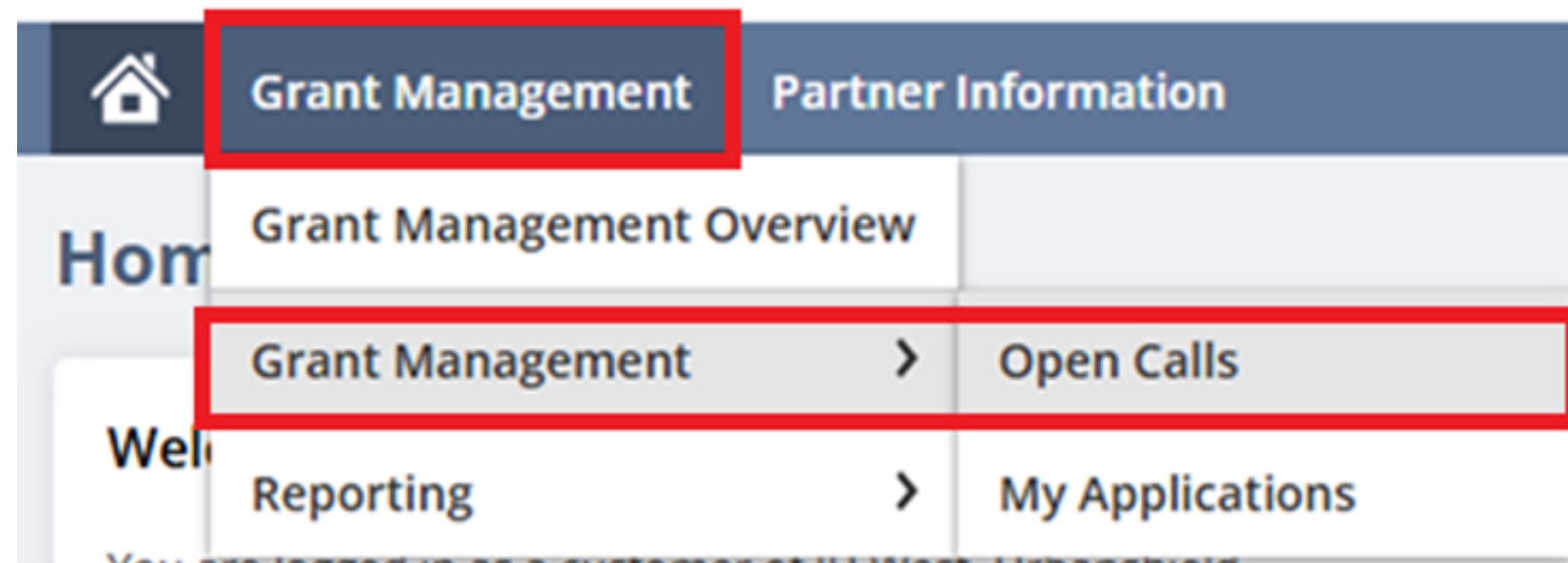
